GENERAL INFORMATION

Passport and Visa

For most participants residing outside of China, a valid passport and a visa are required to enter the country. Upon receiving your registration form, abstract and registration fee, the organizing committee will send an official invitation letter with which you can apply for a visa at the Chinese Embassy or the nearest Consulate General of China.

Insurance

The organizers cannot be responsible for personal accidents or material damage, which may occur to participants during the conference or tours. It is advisable that participants obtain adequate travel and health insurance before leaving their respective countries.

Currency Exchange

In China, only RMB (Chinese money) is used. Exchange centers can be found at airports, most hotels and large shopping centers. When exchanging money, keep your receipt, with which you can change any remaining RMB back to foreign currency when leaving China.

Visa, Mastercard, American Express, Diners Club, Million, JCB, and other credit cards are accepted in many department stores and hotels. The Bank of China and hotels can cash traveler's cheques issued by some foreign banks. You will need to show your passport and pay some amount of commission.

REGISTRATION

All those wishing to attend the congress are requested to register from our website before Feb.1, 2011. Detailed information on online registration will appear on our website. The registration fee for all participants covers full scientific activities, all printed materials of the congress and welcome reception. Registration fees of active participants and family include Banquet fee. However, students should pay extra money for banquet.
